

City Ordinance No 7

The city of Albany does ordain as follows:

- Sect 1 That the owners of lots upon Lyon Street between Weber Street and 9th Street in the City of Albany be and they are hereby required at their own expense under the supervision of the committee on streets and public property, to grade bridge and gravel said street as hereinafter directed in front of their respective lot or lots.
- Sect 2 That the grade on said street shall be designated by said committee on streets and public property with or without the aid of a surveyor as said committee shall deem best.
- Sect 3 That said street shall be graded to the width of 20 feet 10 feet on each side of the center line thereof and to the depth of not less than four inches. the gravel to be used to be as clean of dirt sand and debris as can reasonably be obtained.
- Sect 4 That all necessary grading shall be done on or before the first day of June 1871 and the grading and bridging done before the first day of August 1st 1871.
- Sect 5 That in case the owner of any lot on said street shall neglect fail or refuse to grade or gravel in front of their respective lots as hereinafter designated then it shall be the duty of the Marshall to cause the same to be done at the expense of the said property holder which expense the Marshall shall collect from the owner of said property by an action before the recorder of said City.
- Sect 6. This ordinance to take effect and be in force five days after its passage.

City Ordinance No 8

The city of Albany does ordain as follows:

Sect 1 That the owners of Lots upon Elmworth Street between Water Street and 9th Street in the city of Albany be and they are hereby required at their own expense under the supervision of the committee on streets and public property to grade and gravel said Street as hereinafter directed in front of their respective lot or lots:

Sect 2 That the grade on said Street shall be determined by said committee on streets and public property with or without the aid of a surveyor as said committee shall deem best

Sect 3 That said Street shall be graded to the width of 20 feet 10 feet on each side of the center line thereof and to the depth of not less than four inches the gravel to be used to be as clear of dirt sand and debris as can reasonably be obtained,

Sect 4 That all necessary grading shall be done on or before the first day of June 1871 and the graving done before the first day of August A.D. 1871
