

City Ordinance No 13, "Entitled,

An ordinance to amend Ordinance  
No 3 relating to city Licences,

"The City of Albany does ordain as follows;

Sect 1<sup>st</sup> That city Ordinance No 3 entitled  
an ordinance to impose and regulate  
licences in the City of Albany be and  
the same is hereby amended as follows

1<sup>st</sup> Article 11 in Section 9 of said Ordinance  
shall read "Auctioneers" shall pay a  
quarterly licence of three dollars,  
Every person shall be deemed an Auctioneer  
within the meaning of this act whose  
business it is to offer property for sale  
at public outcry

2 That Article 12 of Section 9 of said  
Ordinance shall be amended, by striking  
out the word and figure three (3) in the  
11<sup>th</sup> line of the published copy of said  
ordinance and inserting the word "One,"  
instead of the word & figure so stricken out  
making the clause read "One for each  
additional animal used or drawing  
such vehicle the additional sum of one  
dollar

3 That nothing contained in article  
of Section 9 of said Ordinance shall be  
construed so as to require persons engaged in  
hauling wood gravel or other commodities  
from outside the city limits into the city, or  
in plowing or scraping for the purpose of  
grading the public streets, alleys, railways  
or other public improvements within the  
city limits, to pay a city Licence,

Sect 2 Any ordinance or part of an ordinance h[an]tofor  
p[er]pet[ual] inconsistant with the provisions of this  
Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed

Sect 3 This ordinance shall take effect and be in  
force from and after five days from the date  
of its passage
