

Ordinance No. 58  
 Ordinance to provide for the Com-  
 pensation of Chief Engineer of Albany  
 Fire Department

Be it Ordained by the Common  
 Council of the City of Albany

Sec. 1. The Chief Engineer of Al-  
 bany Fire Department shall  
 receive for his services the sum  
 of \$50.00 gold coin per quarter  
 commencing July 1<sup>st</sup> 1876

Sec. 2. He shall, by virtue of his  
 Office be Fire Warden

Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of the  
 Recorder on the last day of each  
 quarter to draw an Order on  
 the City Treasurer in favor of  
 the Chief Engineer for the amount  
 of his Compensation then due

Sec. 4. If Charges are preferred  
 against the Chief Engineer for non  
 performance of duty, he shall re-  
 ceive no pay until the Charges are  
 determined.

Sec. 5. Upon the failure of Chief  
 Engineer to perform his duty as  
 provided in the City Ordinance, he  
 shall forfeit all pay and Com-  
 pensation hereby provided for  
 upon his conviction thereof

This Ordinance to be in force  
 from and after five days af-  
 ter its publication
