

Ordinance No. (63)

Be it ordained by the
Common Council of the
City of Albany: That section
Twenty nine (29) of Ordinance
No. (8) be amended so as to read
as follows:

Hotels, Inns and Taverns shall
be classified and rated accord-
ing to the monthly rental of
the house and property intended
to be occupied for said purpose
as follows: to wit:

All cases where the rent or
valuation of the monthly rental
of said house and property
shall be \$20.00 or less the
occupant shall pay a license of
\$2.50 per quarter: In all cases
where the rent or valuation of the
monthly rental shall be more
than twenty and less than fifty
dollars, the occupant shall pay
a quarterly license of \$5.00. In
all cases where the rent or valuation
of the monthly rental shall be
more than fifty and less than
one hundred dollars the occupant
shall pay a quarterly license of
\$10.00 in all cases where the
monthly rental or valuation of
the monthly rental shall exceed
one hundred dollars the occupant
in addition to the license hereinbefore
prescribed shall pay \$2.50 for
each additional \$25.00 monthly rent
or valuation of monthly rent

Every place where food or lodging is provided for and furnished to travelers or sojourners in view of payment thereof shall be regarded as a Hotel Inn or Tavern under this Ordinance
