

Ordinance No 40

To amend Section 14 of Ordinance No. 10 of the laws of the City of Albany, relating to City Police.

Be it Ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany, That Section 14 of Ordinance No. 10 of the laws of the City of Albany relating to Police be, and the same is hereby amended, so as to read as follows,

Sec. 14. Any person who shall keep a house of ill fame resorted to for the purpose of prostitution, gambling, or business, or who shall reside in such house for the purposes aforesaid shall, on conviction before the Recorder be fined in any sum not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, and in default of the payment of such fine may be imprisoned not to exceed thirty nor less than fifteen days.

The common reputation of such houses or the occupants thereof shall be sufficient inducement to warrant conviction.

The Section of the Ordinance hereby amended being deemed insufficient for the suppression of the crime described in said Section
