

Ordinance No 82

Relating to granting the right of way
for the construction of a flume on
the west side of Ferry Street

Be It Ordained by the Common
Council of the City of Albany that
John A Crawford the present owner
of the Albany & Saratoga Water
Ditch or Canal and his heirs assigns
and successors in interest in said Canal
have the right to dig a race and build
a flume on the west side of Ferry
Street either under the side walk
or east thereof from the junction
of Eighth and Ferry Street to the
Millsville River of sufficient
width and depth to conduct
through the dam (2000) two thousand
~~with~~ feet of water per minute,
and the right to build and maintain
said flume & to conduct and
pass through the dam the said two
thousand feet of water per minute
from said Albany & Saratoga Water
Ditch or Canal is hereby granted
unto the said John A Crawford
and his heirs, assigns and successors
in interest in said Canal forever

Provided that the construction of said
ditch or race shall not in any way conflict
with the provisions of any ordinance
now in existence
