

Ordinance No 102.

Relating to City Police

Be it Ordained by the common  
Council of the City of Albany,

Section 1

That it shall be unlawful  
for any person to blow a Police whistle or  
any whistle the noise of which resembles  
a Police whistle within the corporate  
limits of the City of Albany, unless such  
person is in distress and wishes the aid  
and assistance of a policeman.

And any person violating this  
ordinance shall upon conviction thereof  
before the Recorder be fined in the sum  
of not more than twenty or less than  
two dollars, or imprisoned in the City  
jail not more than ten or less than  
two days

Section 2.

This ordinance to take effect  
and be in force from and after five days  
after its publication.
