

Ordinance No. 103

An ordinance to license Wash houses  
and laundries

Be it ordained by the common council  
of the city of Albany,

Section 1. That every person who shall keep  
within the limits of the city any wash house  
or laundry, shall pay a quarterly license of  
fifteen dollars.

Section 2. That the licenses for Wash houses,  
and laundries shall be taken out and issued in  
accordance with Sections Eighteen, nineteen  
Twenty one, Twenty two, Twenty four, and Twenty  
five, of Ordinance number eight, approved April  
12, 1873.

Section 3. That if any person or  
persons shall carry on keep or maintain  
any Wash house or laundry without first  
having taken out the license provided for  
in this ordinance upon conviction  
thereof before the Recorder he or they shall  
be fined in a sum not less than ten or  
more than seventy five dollars or imprisoned  
in the city jail not less than fifteen days.

Section 4. This ordinance to take  
effect and be in force from and after five  
days after its publication.
