

Ordinance No. 107.

An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Broadalbin Street from the Milldam to the center of the Alley between First and Second Streets by building, constructing and laying a sewer.

Section I That that portion of Broadalbin Street lying between the Milldam and the center of the Alley between first and second streets be improved by building, laying and constructing a sewer as hereinafter provided.

Section II That that portion of the street necessary for digging the trenches shall be cleared of all obstructions by the water mains, at the expense of the contractor, who shall open the pipes as laid and be removed, and place all portions of the street improved in a good condition as the same was at the time of commencing the work, except such portions as the Committee on "Streets and Public Property" may direct to be omitted.

Section III The improvement shall consist of building, constructing and laying a sewer of Terra Cotta pipe twelve inches inside diameter, with catch basins, manholes, lamp-holds, feet and branches at such places as may be designated.

Section IV The work to be done and material used to be the best in accordance with the survey to be made by the City Surveyor and the plans and specifications to be drafted by the Committee on Streets and Public Property and filed in the office of the City Recorder and the said plans and specifications for a sewer from the Milldam to the center of the Alley between first and second streets.

Section V The Committee on "Streets and Public Property" shall at all times have the power to reject any material and prevent the use thereof by the Contractor in the construction of the sewer if in their judgment the same is unsuitable or does not conform to the plan and specifications; and the work shall in all things be completed to the entire satisfaction of the Committee on Streets and Public Property.

Section 11. The Contractor shall take entire charge of the work during its progress, and shall be responsible for any loss or damage occasioned by his carelessness or neglect, and replace all sidewalks, pavements, curbs, gutters or other fixtures removed by him in a good condition as when removed.

Section 12. That after the survey and plans and specifications, as provided by Section 10, shall be adopted by the Common Council of the City of Albany, - shall proceed to let the contract, for building, laying and constructing the sewer therein provided for, according to the laws providing for the manner of letting contracts by the City.

Section 13. This Ordinance to be in force from and after five days after its publication.
