

Ordinance No 129.

X An Ordinance to prevent the growth of Thistles, and other noxious weeds, within the limits of the City of Albany.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany:

Rec'd I. It shall be the duty of the City Marshal to insert, or cause to be inserted in the official paper of the City, a notice requiring all Thistles, and other noxious weeds within the limits of the City to be cut down, dug up, or otherwise destroyed.

Rec'd II. Every owner, or occupant of all occupied premises; and every owner or agent of all unoccupied premises, within the corporate limits of the City of Albany who shall permit or allow any Thistles, or other noxious weeds to blossom or grow upon such premises, or in front of, or abutting upon the premises, owned or occupied by them, or for which they are the agents, after the publication of the notice herein mentioned, shall upon conviction before the recorder, be liable to a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than ten dollars, or imprisonment in the City Jail not less than two (2), nor more than five (5) days.

Rec'd III. This Ordinance to be in force, from and after five days from publication.
