

✓ Ordinance No. 139.

Ord. No. 139 An Ordinance relating to the assessment, levy and
Rep. 150th Collection of City Taxes.

The People of the city of Albany do

ordain as follows:

Section I. The Recorder shall provide an assessment roll
in the following form - to wit:

and that the assessment of the city of Albany shall be
made upon said roll as directed by section 103 of the
City Charter.

Section II. Before the compilation of the assessment roll as provided
in section 103 of the City Charter, the Recorder shall give
ten days notice of the time and place of the meeting of the
City Council to sit as a board of equalization, by
publication in a newspaper published in and of
general circulation in the city of Albany.

Section III. Within ten days from the date of the levy of the
tax as provided in section 105 of the City Charter the
Recorder shall complete and extend upon the assessment
roll the amount of tax due from each person firm or
Corporation therein and place the said assessment roll
with said taxes extended thereon, in the hands of the
City Marshall for the collection of said tax.

Section IV. It shall be the duty of the City Marshall to collect
all taxes, and receipt for the same. He shall number
all receipts consecutively and shall retain a stub
of each receipt showing the number, date, persons to whom
issued and the amount thereof. He shall enter the number
of each receipt, and the amount thereof on the assessment
roll in appropriate columns opposite the name of the
person to whom the receipt is issued, and he shall
immediately before returning the tax roll note thereon
under appropriate headings the amount of taxes
collected; and the Marshall shall likewise
note in appropriate columns on said tax roll
all taxes collected upon any alias warrant.

Sectionth. The City Council shall at the first regular meeting thereof after the return of the tax roll as prescribed in section 107 of the City Charter order the City Recorder to immediately issue and cause to file taxroll & warrant as provided in section 108 of said City Charter, and deliver the same to the Sheriff, who shall return the same as provided in said section 108 within forty days from the date of said warrant, and any alias warrant issued in pursuant of section 116 of said Charter shall be returned in the same form as the original warrant.

Sectionth. City orders issued by the Recorder shall be rendered for City taxes; provided that the amount of said orders shall not exceed the amount of taxes payable by the party presenting the same.

Sectionth. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with, herewith are hereby repealed.
