Ordinance No. 144.

All Ordinances granting the right of way to Willamette Valley and Coast Railroad Company, and along La Fayette Street and across Utala, First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh, Eighth and Ninth Streets in the City of Albany, Linn County Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section I. That there be and is hereby granted to the Willamette Valley and Coast Railroad Company the exclusive right of way for its railroad telegraph line and pavitales and side tracks over and along La Fayette Street, and across Utala, First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh, Eighth and Ninth Streets in the City of Albany, Linn County Oregon. Said Company and their successors and assigns to have use and enjoy said right of way as long as they shall use the same for the proper operation of said road.

Section II. Said Company as long as it uses said right of way over and across said streets, shall construct and maintain the necessary crossings. Provided that the City of Albany hereby expressly reserves the right to fix the grade on any of said streets, and to prescribe the manner of constructing crosswalks and necessary and proper crossings thereon and to prescribe the rate of speed at which cars may be run over and along said streets, which shall not be more than at the rate of eight miles per hour. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
