

## Ordinance, No. 167

An Ordinance to amend Section One of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to provide for the prevention of fires and the protection of persons and property endangered thereby,"

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

*amended* Section 1. That Section 1, of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to provide for the prevention of fires, and the protection of persons and property endangered thereby" be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. That the South half of Blocks three (3), four (4), five (5), and six (6) and the North half of Block seven (7) and the whole of Blocks eight (8) nine (9) and ten (10) of the City of Albany, and the South half of Block One and the North half of Block Two (2) in the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany according to the maps, plats and surveys of said City of Albany and said Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, now on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk of Linn County Oregon, be and the same are hereby declared to be within the fire limits of the City of Albany.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
