

Ordinance ~~2004~~ ^{3,000}

An Ordinance to establish the grade of certain streets in the city of Albany.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1: The established grade of Ninth, Tenth, and Eleventh streets, from the east line of Vine street, to the east line of Blacworth street, and of Calapooias, Washington, Perry, Broadalbin and Ellsworth streets from the south line of Eighth street, to the north line of Twelfth street, shall be in conformity, to the survey and plat made by J. A. Warner in the year 1890, adopted by the Council July 8th 1890, and now on file in the Office of the City Recorder.

Section 2: gutters of streets to be twelve (12) feet from line of blocks abutting thereto.

Section 3: The center of the finished grade street shall conform to the established grade, the gutter to be eight tenths ($\frac{8}{10}$) of a foot lower than the center of street, and there shall be not less than (6) six inches of gravel in the center of the street, and not less than (3) three inches of gravel at the edge of gutter.

Section 4: All water mains or pipes laid

in the streets shall be placed not less than two (2) feet below the level of the surface or top of the street gutter.

Section 5: All gas mains or pipes laid in the streets shall be placed not less than three (3) feet below the level of the surface or top of street gutter.

Section 6: The under ground sewers to be laid, so that the top of the sewer shall be not less than three (3) feet below the level of the surface or top of street gutter.

Section 7: The top of sidewalks to be made even with the top of the grade of the center of the street, and shade trees planted or set out, to be located not less than ten (10) feet from the line of the block abutting upon the streets.

Section 8: No, water, sewer, gas, or other pipes or mains shall be laid in the streets by any person or persons, or firm, or corporation, for rent, hire, domestic or sanitary purposes, without the right or permit to lay such pipes, or mains is granted by a special ordinance passed by the Council of the City of Albany.

Section 9: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the mayor.
