

Ordinance No-215.

On Ordinance to prevent Minors under certain ages from going abroad upon or roaming about any Street or Streets of the City of Albany after certain hours at night, without a written permit signed by the Parent or Guardian of such minors, or unless such Minors shall be accompanied at such time by his or her Parent or Guardian, or have necessary business at such time or about such Street or Streets.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Sectio[n] 1. That hereafter it shall be unlawful for any male Minor under the age of Eighteen years or female Minor under the age of Sixteen years to go abroad upon or roam about any Street or Streets of the City of Albany after the hour of Eight o'clock at night at any time during the months of January, February, March, October, November and December of any year, or after the hour of nine o'clock at night at any time during the months of April, May, June, July, August and September of any year unless such Minor shall bear in his or her possession at such a written permit signed by his or her Parent or Guardian allowing him or her so to be upon such Street or Streets at such time, or shall be accompanied at such time by his or her, parent or guardian or unless such Minor shall, at such time,

have necessary business upon or about
such Street or Streets.

Section 2. That if at any time the Marshall
or any Police officer of said City shall
know or learn of any male minor
under the age of Eighteen years or female
minor under the age of Sixteen years,
being or having been, abroad upon or
roaming about, any Street or Streets
of said City after the hour of eight
o'clock at night at any time during
the months of January, February, March,
October, November and December of any
year after the passage of this ordinance
or after the hour of nine o'clock at night
at any time during the months of
April, May, June, July, August and
September of any year after the pas-
sage of this ordinance unaccompanied
at such time by the parent or guardian
of such minor, it shall be the duty
of such officer to demand such minor
to show him a written permit signed
by his or her parent or guardian, allow-
ing him or her to so be upon such
Street or Streets at such time, and it
shall be the duty of such minor
to show to such officer a written per-
mit signed by the parent or guardian
of such minor allowing him or her
to so be upon or about such Street or
Streets, at such time, if such minor
has such permit, and if such
minor has no such permit, then
it shall be his or her duty at such
time, to truthfully disclose to such
officer any necessary business which such
minor has had upon such Street or

States of said City at such time, and if such minor shall fail to show to such officer or such demand such permit, or shall at such time fail to truthfully disclose to him any business which he or she has or had on or about such Street or Streets, at such time, such minor shall be deemed guilty of violating the provisions of this section.

Section 3. Any minor who shall violate any of the provisions of Section 1 and 2 of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorders Court be fined not less than five dollars nor more than one fifty dollars or be imprisoned in the City jail not less than two days nor more than twenty five days at the discretion of the court.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
