

## Ordinance No: 267.

An Ordinance Changing the grade of all that portion of Calapooia Street, in the city of Albany Oregon, between the south line of First Street and the north line of Fourth Street, and of all that portion of the grade of Second Street, in said city between the west line of Washington Street, and the east line of Calapooia Street, and all of that portion of Third Street grade between the west line of Washington Street, and the east line of Vine Street, so as to conform to the survey of the grade of said portions of said Calapooia, Second, and Third Streets as made by and shown by the survey of City Surveyor W. B. Barr, made in the year 1892, and filed in the Office of the Recorder of said city on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of October 1892.

Ordinance No 267

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the grade of all that portion of Calapooia Street between the south line of First Street and the north line of Fourth Street, in the city of Albany Oregon, and all that portion of the grade of Second Street in said city, between the west line of Washington Street, and the east line of Calapooia Street, and all that portion of the grade of Third Street between the west line of Washington Street, and the east line of Vine Street in said city, be and the same is hereby changed and altered so as to conform to the survey of the grade of said portions of said Calapooia, Second and Third Streets, as shown, and made by the survey of City Surveyor W. B. Barr, which said survey was made in the year 1892, and filed in the Office of the Recorder of said City, on the eleventh day of October 1892.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from, and after its approval by the Mayor.
