

Ordinance No. 298.

An Ordinance declaring the probable cost of constructing a sidewalk on the North side of First Street in front of, and abutting on lot 8 block 130 Hackleman's addition to the City of Albany, owned by W.M. Ketcham, and J.J. Suberville, Trustee, and directing the City Recorder to enter a statement thereof in the docket of City liens.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of \$8,00 heretofore ascertained, and determined by the Council to be the probable cost of constructing a sidewalk, and curb on the North side of First Street, in front of, and abutting lot 8, in block 130, Hackleman's addition to the City of Albany, said property being owned by W.M. Ketcham, and J.J. Suberville, he and the same is freely charged, and assessed to said above described lot, and the owners thereof above named, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to enter a proper statement of such assessment in the docket of City liens in accordance with the provisions of Section 69, Chapter 7, of the Charter of the City of Albany.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval by the Mayor.
