

Ordinance 300.

An Ordinance relating to a Construction of a sidewalk on the north side of First Street in front of lot 8, Block 130, in Hackleman's addition to the City of Albany, and fixing the time within which said sidewalk shall be built, and prescribing the manner in which it shall be constructed.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1: The City of Albany having heretofore determined to build a sidewalk and curb on the north side of First Street abutting on lot 8, block 130, Hackleman's addition to the City of Albany, and having given proper notice of said proposed improvement, and ascertained and determined the probable cost thereof, it is hereby ordained the said sidewalk and curb be, and it is hereby ordered built.

Section 2: Said sidewalk, and curb shall be of the dimensions, and built, and constructed as provided in sections 1st and 4th of Ordinance 293, of the City of Albany, and shall in every way meet the requirements, and provisions of said Ordinance.

Section 3: The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to advertise for bids for the Construction of said sidewalk and curb, for at least 5-days before the next meeting of the City Council, by posting notices in 5 public places in the City of Albany, and shall in said notices describe the work to be done, with reasonable certainty, and shall state in said notices that all bids will be subject to rejection by the Council in case such bid, or bids shall be deemed unreasonable by said Council or in ^{the} case of any person bidding for such work who has heretofore bid, or constructed such work, and who has been delinquent.

Section 4: The Construction of said sidewalk, and curb shall be let to the lowest bidder therefore subject to the

provisions of section 3 of this ordinance, and subject to the provisions of section 82, of chapter 7, of the Charter of the city of Albany, but before entering into a contract for the construction of said sidewalk, and curb the successful bidder, thereof shall enter into a good, and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of his contract.

Section 5: Said sidewalk, and curb shall be constructed within 10 days after a bid for the construction thereof shall be accepted.

Section 6: This ordinance shall be in full force, and effect after its approval by the mayor.


