

Ordinance No. 302.

An Ordinance, to provide for the payment of interest on City Warrants, presented to the City Treasurer, Ord. 302 for payment, and endorsed by him "not paid" and 1419 for want of funds."

The People of the City of Albany, do,
ordain as follows:

Section 1. When a City warrant is presented to the Treasurer of the City of Albany for payment, and there are no funds in the Treasury to pay the same, he shall endorse thereon the words, "not paid for want of funds," and the date of such presentation over his official signature, and a warrant so endorsed shall draw interest, at the rate of six (6) per cent per annum until paid, or until notice is given by the Treasurer, that he has funds to pay the same. Notice designating the warrant to be paid, shall be given by publishing the same in the official paper of the city, or if there be no such official paper, then in any daily, or weekly newspaper published in the City of Albany; the interest on such warrant, shall cease from the date of the publication of such notice.

Section 2. Ordinance no. 301, and all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force, and after its approval by the Mayor.
