

Ordinance No. 308:

Are, Ordinances providing for the protection of the City Pound and of the Poundmaster of Albany, Oregon, in the discharge of his duties as such officer.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That any Person, or Persons, who shall unlawfully remove, or attempt to remove, or take from the City Pound of the City of Albany, Oregon, any animal confined therein, or who shall in any manner, or way willfully or maliciously damage the City Pound, or any part thereof, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, shall be fined not less than ten dollars, nor more than fifty dollars, or imprisoned in the City jail not less than five days, nor more than twenty-five days, or be punished by both such fine, and imprisonment, at the discretion of the Court.

Section 2: That any Person, or Persons, who shall take, or attempt to take any animal, legally in the possession of the Poundmaster, from such officer, or who shall interfere with, or resist such officer while in the discharge of his duties, as Poundmaster of said City of Albany, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, be fined not less than twenty dollars, nor more than one hundred dollars, or imprisoned in the City jail not less than ten days, nor more than fifty days, or punished by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section 3: This ordinance, shall take effect, and be in full force from, and after its approval by

The Mayor.
