

ORDINANCE NO. 319.

Ordinance
No. 319

An Ordinance authorizing, and enforcing the Mayor, and Recorder of the city of Albany, Oregon, to enter into, and sign written articles of agreement, with D.V. Hall, of Gates, Oregon, for furnishing the city of Albany, Oregon, with lumber for the year ending the second Tuesday in January 1899.

The People of the city of Albany, do ordain as follows:

Section 1: That, the Mayor, and Recorder of the city of Albany, be, and they are hereby authorized, directed, and enforced, enter into, and sign written articles of agreement, with D.V. Hall, of Gates, Oregon, for furnishing, by the said D.V. Hall, to the city of Albany, Oregon, until the second Tuesday in January, A.D. 1899, being the 24th day thereof, said lumber so furnished by the said, D.V. Hall, to the city of Albany, Oregon, to be of the best quality of rough red fir lumber, and to be delivered, free on board the cars, in Albany, Oregon, at the rate, and price of (\$7.00) seven dollars per thousand feet, in car load lots, and to be paid for in the same way, and manner, as other claims against the city are audited, and paid.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force, from, and after its approval by the Mayor.
