

ORDINANCE NO. 326.

Ord. No. 326

An Ordinance, authorizing, and empowering the Mayor and Recorder, of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into, and sign written Articles of agreement, with J. E. Frick of Portland, Oregon, for digging a trench, in Third street, from the "Albany and Pauliani" Ditch, to Ellsworth street, in said City.

The People of the city of Albany, do Ordain as follows:

Section 1:

That, the Mayor, and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, be, and they are hereby, authorized, directed, and empowered, to enter into, and sign written Articles of Agreement, with J. E. Frick of Portland, Oregon, for the digging of a trench for a "Water Pipe Line", in Third street, from the "Albany and Pauliani" Ditch, to Ellsworth street in said City, at the rate and price of 27¢ per cubic yard, as set forth, and stated in the bid of said J. E. Frick, which was submitted to, and accepted by the City Council of said City, at a regular meeting held September 13<sup>th</sup> 1898.

Section 2:

This ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from, and after its approval by the Mayor.
