

## ORDINANCE NO. 331

Ord No. 331 An Ordinance Providing for the Purchasing of Five Hundred Feet of Rubber Fire Hose "Mallin Bros" Brand, from the "Gutta Percha and Rubber Manufacturing Company of Portland, Oregon, and Directing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into, and sign a contract in writing for the purchase of said hose.

The People of the City of Albany, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That there be, and is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of (\$50.) Fifty-Hundred Dollars, for the purchasing of (500) five hundred feet of the best quality of Rubber Fire Hose of the "Mallin Bros" Brand, from the "Gutta Percha, and Rubber" Manufacturing Company of Portland - Oregon, for the use of the Fire Department of said city of Albany. And that, the Mayor, and Recorder of the City of Albany, be, and they are hereby authorized, directed, and commanded to enter into, and sign for and in behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, written articles of agreement, with the said "Gutta Percha, and Rubber Manufacturing Company," upon the terms, and conditions of the proposal submitted by the said "Gutta Percha, Rubber and Manufacturing Company," to the City Council of said city, <sup>and accepted by said council</sup> at a regular meeting held February 28-1899, for the purchase of said fire hose.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
