ORDINANCE NO. 336.

An Ordinance to prohibit the making of a fire on any of the Alleys, Arches, or Streets, within the fire limits of the City of Albany, Oregon, as defined by Ordinance, and to provide for the punishment of any person, or persons violating this Ordinance.

Ord No. 336 The People of the City of Albany, Oregon, do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That, it shall be unlawful, for any person, or persons, to make any open fire, or cause such fire to be made on any of the Alleys, Arches, or Streets within the fire limits of the City of Albany, Oregon, as defined and fixed by Ordinance, for the purpose of burning rubbish, trash, or combustible material of any kind, or for any purpose whatever.

Section 2: Any person, or persons, violating the provisions of Section 1, of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of said City, be fined not less than five dollars, nor more than twenty dollars, or imprisoned in the City Jail not less than two, nor more than ten days.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
