

ORDINANCE NO. 339.

An Ordinance to fix and regulate the Compensation of the City Marshal of Albany, Oregon, and to repeal Ordinance No. 273, approved December 2nd, 1893, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance.

Ord. No. 339

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1: The Marshal of the City of Albany, Oregon, shall receive in full Compensation for his services a salary of \$2000) Seven Hundred and twenty dollars, per year, which shall be paid monthly out of the City Treasury the same as other Taxes against the City are audited, and paid.

Section 2: Ordinance No. 273, approved December 2nd, 1893, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force, on and after the first Monday in January 1899.
