

ORDINANCE No. 345

Ord. No. 342 The City of Albany and empowering the Mayor and Board of the City of Albany to enter into and sign on behalf of said City, a written agreement with the Oregon Electric Light & Telephone Company, for the purpose of providing the City of Albany with electric light and power from the date of the execution of the contract.

That the Mayor and Board of the City of Albany do hereby order as follows:

Section I. That the Mayor and Board of the City of Albany, Oregon, and are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to enter into and sign on behalf of said City, written articles of agreement with the Oregon Electric Light & Telephone Company or Albany Oregon, their successors or assigns, for the purpose of providing the City of Albany with electric light and power from the day of the execution of the contract to the 1st day of July 1901 with 10,200 candle power Electric Arc Street lights, and a discontinuous night service at the price of \$5.00 per month being at the rate of \$5.00 per each light per month, the price to be paid for each additional light which may be ordered by the Board of the City of said City, and furnished by said Company above the number of 10 lights to be \$5.00 per month for each of such additional lights so ordered, and shall be included in monthly payments as part of the contract during the term and continuance of the contract, authorized by this Ordinance.

Section II. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor. Approved October 26, 1900
