An Ordinance to license and regulate
vehicles, and carrying in the City of Albany
and to provide a penalty for violation thereof
The People of the City of Albany do hereby
enact as follows:

Section I. That no person or any person, operating
any cart, cab, horse-drawn carriage, wagon,
earth or other vehicle used for the transportation
of passengers or any articles, live animals,
hardware, earth, gravel, building material, or
other substance within the corporate limits of
the City of Albany, (except for some carrying
on deliberately to and from a part of the city) with
or without a "team, pack-trail" or hire "directly or
indirectly, shall pay a quarterly license
fee of \$5.00 for each vehicle drawn by man or
animal, and for each additional animal used
in drawing such vehicle, the additional sum
of \$1.00. - Provided that nothing in this ordinance
shall be construed so as to require persons drawing
earth, sand, gravel or lime (but for the improvement
of the public alleys, bridge crossings, streets or
highways of the city, or drawing wood, gravel or
other commodities from outside the city limits, or
plowing or scraping the public alleys, streets, railroads
or other public improvements, or persons engaged
in the sale of milk, or dairy products within the
city, or Hotel Keepers or omnibuses run by them
for the sole purpose of carrying passengers without
hire or charge but who have respective notices of
the Board of Steamboat Landings in said City
to procure a license therefor.

Section II. That if any person or persons owning or operating
any vehicle used for any of the purposes specified
in the above Section shall do any carrying
or hauling or do any act for the doing of which
a license is required by this ordinance, without
first taking out such license, as in that
they may be required, or violate any of the provisions
of this ordinance, in which case they shall
upon conviction thereof before the Recorder, for
every such offense, besides being liable for the
