ORDINANCE NO. 347

Ord No 344 (b) It is hereby enacted that upon the
Amend 347 Steel Bridge extending to the City of Albany
Rep 1506 and part of said bridge situated within
the corporate limits of the City of Albany;
so that it toll gates or gates 18 hours, and to
provide for the collection of toll from all
persons so as to pay the cost of maintaining said bridge
as herein directed to be done.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as
follows;

Section I. That there shall be built constructed and main-
tained, one or more gates which shall be known
and used as toll gate on the steel bridge
aforementioned above it a. mile or more within the
corporate limits of the City of Albany, and
which said bridge belongs to said City.

Section II. That there shall be charged and collected from
all persons and property passing through
the bridge aforesaid, so built and maintained
upon said steel bridge, toll as and for
compensation for traveling over and across
said bridge as follows:

For each vehicle drawn by four horses, mules or
oxen, round trip or one way 25¢.

For each vehicle drawn by two horses, mules or
oxen round trip or one way 15¢.

For each vehicle drawn by one horse, mules or
oxen round trip or one way 10¢.

For each bicycle or tricycle round trip or one way 5¢.

For each tandem round trip or one way 5¢ if drawn
by two persons 10¢ round trips or one way.

For each person or horseback round trip or one way 10¢.

For each traction engine round trip or one way 5¢.

For each wood cart round trip or one way 5¢.

For each steam engine one way \$2.00

For each boat one way 25¢.

For each dog one way 5¢.

For each horse or mule not having drivers
less or less than 10¢.

For each sled or sledge one way 5¢.

For each dog sled one way 5¢.

ORDINANCE NO.

Section III. That at the City Bridge shall at all times to time elect one or more persons as Toll Collectors whose duty it shall be to take charge of the Bridge and the toll gate thereon and to collect toll from all persons and for all property in the land and described in Section two of this ordinance, that passes through the toll gate across or said bridge and to regulate the travel of persons and property passing over the bridge across said bridge.

Section IV. That no person shall be permitted to cross said bridge alone or with any of the property named and provided in section two of this ordinance without first having paid the toll or tolls required by said section two to the toll collector at the gate on said bridge, ^{or} ~~any person~~ traveling on said bridge who shall go through or around the gate with intent to avoid the payment of such toll or who shall refuse to make such payment, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder of the City of Albany shall be punished by a fine of not less than ~~one~~ nor more than ~~35~~ ²⁵ dollars or by imprisonment in the city jail not less than two nor more than twelve days.

Section V. That no person shall ride on horseback, or drive any team or loose horses or cattle or on any said bridge faster than as walk or shall drive through the toll gate or across upon said bridge without first having paid the amount provided for toll as provided in section two of this ordinance to the toll collector on said bridge, any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder of the City of Albany shall be punished by a fine of not less than ~~one~~ nor more than ~~35~~ ²⁵ dollars or by imprisonment in the city jail not less than two nor more than twelve days.

ORDINANCE NO. 344

Section VI. It shall be the duty of toll collectors or collectors to be members of the police force, as given by the Charter and it is ordered, annexed to the city of Albany, to the police officers of the City of Albany upon and in the immediate vicinity of said bridge, and they are authorized and empowered to arrest without a warrant, any person or persons that may violate any of the provisions of this ordinance and take the same before the City Recorder.

Section VII. It shall be the duty of the toll collector or collectors to keep the bridge clean and in good order and to make such repairs thereon, as to their collection as may be necessary and proper; and to see that no unnecessary injury or damage is done to said bridge.

Section VIII. It shall be the duty of the toll collector or collectors to make a report in writing at the close of each day, and file the same with the City Recorder, giving the number of persons and the number of each class of property described in section two of this ordinance, that have passed through the toll gate on said bridge and the amount of money collected therefrom and pay to the City Recorder of the city of Albany, all money collected by him taking from said City Recorder a receipt therefor, which receipt shall be filed with the City Treasurer at the end of each month.

Section IX. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
