ORDINANCE NO. 347

Ord No 344
Amend 347
Rep 1506

That there shall be certain tracts upon the
Steel Bridge belonging to the City of Albany
and upon the same the City of Albany within
the corporate limits of said City of Albany;
and that the City of Albany shall have and to
provide for the collection of toll from all
persons and property passing over said bridge
as hereinafter provided.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as
follows:

Section II. That there shall be built, constructed and main-
tained, one or more gates which shall be known
and used as toll gates on the steel bridge
spanning the hole in the city of Albany, and
which said bridge belongs to said City.

Section III. That there shall be charged and collected from
all persons and property passing through
the toll gates, so built and maintained
upon said steel bridge, toll as and for
compensation for traveling over and across
said bridge as follows:

For each vehicle drawn by four horses, mules or
oxen, round trip or one way 25¢

For each vehicle drawn by two horses, mules or
oxen, round trip or one way 15¢

For each vehicle drawn by one horse, mule or
ox, round trip or one way 10¢

For each bicycle or tricycle round trip or one way 5¢

For each tandem wheel used by one person 5¢ if used
by two persons 10¢ round trip or one way.

For each person on horseback round trip or one way 10¢

For each person on foot round trip or one way 5¢

For each horse, mule or ox one way 1/100¢

For each wood saw round trip or one way 5¢

For each traction engine one way 25¢

For each cow one way 2¢

For each goat one way 2¢

For each sheep one way 2¢

For each horse or mule or ox traveling direct
to or from the toll gates one way 5¢

For each horse or mule or ox traveling direct
to or from the toll gates one way 5¢

Section III. That the City Council shall from time to time elect one or more persons as Toll Collectors whose duty it shall be to take charge of the bridge and the toll gate thereon and to collect toll from all persons and for all property, real and personal, described in section two of this ordinance, that pass through the toll gate or across or said bridge and to regulate the travel of persons and property passing over the said bridge.

Section IV. That no person shall be permitted to cross said bridge alone or with any of the property named and provided in section two of this ordinance without first having paid the toll or tolls required by said section two to the toll collector at the toll gate on said bridge; ^{any person} traveling on said bridge who shall go through or around the gate with intent to avoid the payment of such toll or who shall refuse to make such payment, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder of the City of Albany shall be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than \$500 or by imprisonment in the city jail not less than two nor more than twelve days.

Section V. That no person shall ride on horseback, or drive any team or loose horses or cattle on or over said bridge faster than a walk or shall drive through the toll gate or across upon said bridge without first having paid the amount provided for toll as provided in section two of this ordinance to the toll collector on said bridge; any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder of the City of Albany shall be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than \$500 or by imprisonment in the city jail not less than two nor more than twelve days.

Section VI. Toll collectors or collectors are empowered with full police powers, as given by the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany to the police officers of the City of Albany, upon and in the immediate vicinity of said bridge, and they are authorized and empowered to arrest without a warrant any persons or persons that may violate any of the provisions of this ordinance and take the same before the City Recorder.

Section VII. It shall be the duty of the toll collector or collectors to keep the bridge clean and in good order and to make such repairs thereon further to be let in as may be necessary and proper; and to see that no unnecessary injury or damage is done to said bridge.

Section VIII. It shall be the duty of the toll collector or collectors to make a report in writing at the close of each day, and file the same with the City Recorder, giving the number of persons and the number of each class of property described in section two of this ordinance, that have passed through the toll gate on said bridge and the amount of money collected therefor and to pay to the City Recorder of the City of Albany, all money collected by him, taking from said City Recorder a receipt therefor, which receipt shall be filed with the City Treasurer at the end of each month.

Section IX. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
