

ORDINANCE NO. 348

An Ordinance to amend Section II of an ordinance entitled, An ordinance to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments and to provide for the manner of issuing license, approved February 10, 1886.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:
Section I. That section II of an ordinance entitled "An ordinance to tax and regulate certain callings trades and employments, and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses; approved February 10, 1886;" be amended so as to read as follows;

Section II. Hawkers shall pay a license of \$30.00 per day for each day in which they shall conduct their business within the corporate limits of the City of Albany. Any person who offers goods for sale by out-cry upon the streets, or who shall conduct their business from a stand, booth or wagon upon the streets shall be deemed a Hawker within the meaning of this ordinance.

Section II. As there is urgent need for protection of the people of the City of Albany from Hawkers, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its approval by the Mayor.
