

ORDINANCE No. 352

Ord. No. 352 An Ordinance authorizing the building and constructing of an eight-inch vitrified Terra cotta Pipe lateral sewer through the center of Blocks 33 and 40 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and directing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract on the part of the City of Albany for the construction of an eight-inch vitrified Terra cotta pipe lateral sewer through and across the center line of blocks 33 and 40 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, ^{Lincoln} County, Oregon, beginning in the center and at the East line of said Block No. 40 and terminating at the West line of said Block No. 33 and connecting with the main sewer on Madison Street in the said City of Albany, Oregon, and to construct said sewer at the cost and expense of the several owners and holders of lots and parts of lots in said Blocks 33 and 40, benefited thereby.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:-
 Section I. That there shall be built and constructed an eight-inch vitrified terra-cotta pipe lateral sewer through and across the center line of blocks 33 and 40 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, beginning in the center and at the East line of said block 40 and terminating at the West line of said Block No. 33 and connecting with the main sewer in Madison Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and that the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to enter into and sign, on the part of the City of Albany, written articles of agreement for the construction and laying of said eight-inch vitrified terra cotta pipe lateral sewer, through and across the center line of blocks no. 33 and 40 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Lincoln County, Oregon; the same to begin in the center and at the East line of Block no. 40 and terminating at the West line of block No. 33 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany Lincoln County, Oregon, and to be connected with the main sewer in Madison Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and that the cost of the construction and laying of said lateral sewer be assessed to the several owners and holders of lots or parts of lots in said Blocks No. 33 and 40 in

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Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, to be benefited by such lateral sewers, as their respective interests may appear. Provided that said contract shall not be entered into and such articles of agreement signed by the Mayor and Recorder on the part of the City of Albany until after proposals for the construction of said lateral sewers has been advertised for in the manner provided by the City Charter and ordinances of said City regulating and awarding of contracts, and bids have been received and considered by the Council and the cost and expense for constructing said lateral sewers fixed and determined.

Section II. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
