

ORDINANCE No. 357

An Ordinance declaring an Assessment and to fix and establish a lien for sidewalk improvements on Lots 1 & 2 and the West half of Lot 3, in Block No. 12 in the Eastern Addition, to the City of Albany, Oregon, for the construction of a sidewalk on the South side of Fourth Street and adjacent to the above described property in said City.

The People of the City of Albany, Oregon do Ordain as follows.

Section 1. That whereas on the 9th day of July, 1901 a resolution was duly passed by the City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, declaring the intention of the said City to improve ^{by building a sidewalk} South Street on the South side thereof and adjacent to lots No 1, 2, and the West half of lot No. 3, in Block No. 12, in the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, and caused due and legal notice thereof to be given as required by law and no objections or remonstrances being made to the proposed improvement, or the building of said sidewalk, and thereafter on the 23rd day of July, 1901, duly passed an ordinance declaring the time and manner of constructing said sidewalk, and authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of said City to enter into a contract to construct said sidewalk, and authorized the Recorder to advertise for bids therefor, and thereafter the contract being duly made for the construction of said sidewalk and the Superintendent of streets having charge of such work for the City of Albany, as City Engineer, having reported that the work had been completed according to contract and that the cost of advertising and the construction of said work and other costs connected therewith amounted to the sum of \$44.³⁹

Section 2:- That there be and is hereby assessed upon the said lots No. 1 and 2 and the West half of lot No. 3, in Block No. 12, in the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of \$44.³⁹ and that said amount shall be a lien upon said property above described, until the full payment thereof, and that a record of said Lien be entered upon the lien docket.

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of the said city of Albany, and that the Recorder
 do and he is hereby directed to give ^{Joseph Shigley} notice to the
 owner or the reputed owner of said property of
 the assessment of said costs upon said property
 above described, for the improvements so made
 and if said sum is not paid within ten
 days after the giving and service of said notices,
 that the Recorder of the City issue a warrant
 for the collection of said sum, directed to the
 City Marshall to forthwith levy upon and
 sell the hereinabove described property as provided
 by law.

Section 3: - That this ordinance shall be in
 full force and effect from and after its approval
 by the Mayor.
