

## ORDINANCE NO. 367.

Passed by the Council July 8, 1902.

Ord 367 A bill for ordinance authorizing the Mayor  
Passed by and City Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon,  
the Council, to enter into a contract with L. and T. A. Bow-  
July 8, 1902 land for scrapping, cleaning and painting the Iron  
and Woodwork of the Steel Bridge belonging to  
said City and painting the woodwork of said  
bridge.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1:- That the Mayor and Recorder of the  
City of Albany, Oregon be and they are hereby  
authorized to enter into a contract with  
L. and T. A. Bowland for scrapping, cleaning  
and painting the iron and woodwork of  
the steel bridge belonging to said City and for  
painting the woodwork of said bridge, for the  
price of \$350.00 to be paid out of any monies  
not otherwise appropriated out of the bridge fund of  
said city in the hands of the Treasurer.

Section 2:- This ordinance shall be in  
full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
