

ORDINANCE NO. 369

Passed by the council November 20th, 1902.

Ord 369
Passed by of a wooden sidewalk six feet in width
the Council on the south side of fifth street abutting
Nov. 25, 1902 on the north line of lots two, three and
four in block thirty-nine of Hackleman's
second addition to the City of Albany Oregon,
also on the south side of fifth street abutting
on the north line of the northeast quarter
of block thirty-four in Hackleman's second
addition to the City of Albany Oregon; also on
the west side of main street abutting on
the east line of lot four in block fifty-two
in Hackleman's second addition to the City of
Albany; also on the west side of main street
abutting the east line of lot five in block
fifty-two in Hackleman's second addition
to the City of Albany, Oregon and to authorize
the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany
to enter into a contract on the part of the
City of Albany for the construction and repair
of the same, and providing for the cost
and expense of the construction and re-
pairing of the said sidewalk to be assessed
to the holders and owners of lots and
parts of lots abutting and adjoining said
sidewalk.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain
as follows:

Section I: That a wooden sidewalk on the
South side of Fifth street abutting the North
line of Lots 2, 3, 4, 4 in Block 39 in Hackleman's
2nd Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon;
Also on the south side of Fifth street abutting on the
North line of the Northeast quarter of block 34
in Hackleman's second addition to the City of
Albany, Oregon; Also on the West side of
Main street abutting on the East line
of lot 4 in block 52, in Hackleman's Second
Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon;

Also on the West side of Main street abutting
the East line of lot 5 in block 52, in Hackleman's
Second addition to the City of Albany, Oregon; before

and that the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to enter into and sign on the part of the City of Albany written articles of agreement for the construction and repair of the wooden sidewalk six feet in width on south side of Fifth street abutting on the North line of lots 23, - 4, in block 39, in Hackettman's second addition to the City of Albany, Oregon; also on the south side of Fifth street abutting on the North line of the North East quarter of block 34 in Hackettman's second addition to the City of Albany, Oregon; also on the West side of Main street abutting on the East line of Lot 4 in block 52 in Hackettman's second addition to the City of Albany, Oregon; also on the West side of Main Street abutting on the East line of Lot 5, in block 52 in Hackettman's second addition to the City of Albany, Oregon.


That the cost of the construction and repair of said sidewalk be assessed to the several owners and holders of lots and parts of lots abutting on and adjacent to said sidewalk when constructed and repaired. Provided that said contract shall not be entered into and such articles of agreement signed by the Mayor and Recorder on the part of the City until after proposals for the construction and repair of said sidewalk has been advertised for in the manner provided for by the city charter and ordinances regulating and awarding all contracts, and bids have been received and considered by the council, and the costs and expenses of the repairs of said sidewalk have been determined.

Section 2: - This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
