

ORDINANCE No. 377.

Passed by the council June 25 1903

A bill for an ordinance authorizing the building, laying and construction of a wooden sidewalk and curb in front of and adjacent to the following described real property: On the west side of Brier Street abutting on the East line of the South 1/2 of the southeast 1/4 of Block No. 70 0 in the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon the property of W. H. Carter.

Also on the North side of Seventh Street abutting on the south line of the Southeast 1/4 of Block No. 49 in said City, the property of C. C. Cohen

Also on the North side of Seventh Street abutting on the south line of the southeast 1/4 of Block No. 50 in said City, the property of C. P. Wallace.

And to authorize the Mayor and Recorder of said City of Albany Oregon to enter into a contract on the part of the said City for the construction of the same and to provide for the costs and expenses of the building and construction of said sidewalk and curb to be assessed to the owners and holders of said lots and parts of lots and to become a lien upon said lots, abutting and adjoining said improvements for the payment of the construction of such sidewalk and curb.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:-

Section I. That there shall be constructed a wooden sidewalk eight feet in width and a wooden curbing not less than 12 inches in depth and eight inches in width on the west side of Brier Street abutting on the East line of the South 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of Block No. 70 0 in the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon the property of W. H. Carter.

Also on the North side of Seventh Street abutting on the south line of the Southeast 1/4 of Block No. 49 in said City, the property of C. C. Cohen.

Also on the North side of Seventh Street abutting on the South line of the South-west $\frac{1}{4}$ of Block No. 50 in said City, the property of J. P. Wallace

Said sidewalk, and curbing to be constructed and builded in the manner and form provided by ordinance and in accordance with the surveys and specifications now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City of Albany.

Section 2 - That the Mayor and Recorder of said City of Albany be, and they are hereby directed and empowered to enter into and sign on behalf of City of Albany, written articles for the construction of said sidewalk and curb as above described, provided however, that said contract shall not be entered into, on said articles of agreement signed by the Mayor and Recorder on the part of said City until proposals for the construction of said sidewalk and curb have been advertised for in the manner provided for by the City Charter and ordinances regulating the awarding of all contracts and bids have been received and considered by the Council, ^{and the contract awarded by the Council} and the costs and expenses of constructing the same shall have been ascertained, fixed and determined.

Section 3 - That the costs and expenses of laying and constructing said sidewalk and curb together with all costs of Notices, and process in connection therewith shall be assessed to the owners of the several lots and parts of lots abutting on and adjacent to said sidewalk and curb when constructed and

such costs, ~~and expenses~~ ^{shall be made} a lien upon said property for the payment thereof.

Section: - This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.

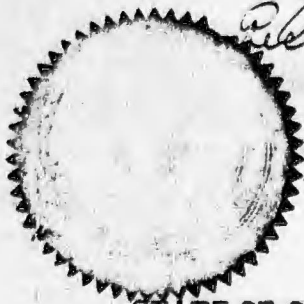
