An Ordinance to protect the fire alarm system and the fire apparatus of the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing a punishment for violation thereof.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section I:- That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to tamper with any of the fire alarm boxes or with the wires or fastenings, or any of the apparatus connected with the fire alarm system of the City of Albany, or with the fire engines, hoses, leaders, water cisterns or anything connected with or pertaining to the city fire apparatus, or to wantonly injure or damage the same.

Section II:- That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to willfully or maliciously make a false alarm for fire or to give an alarm of fire by ringing the fire bell or giving an alarm over the fire alarm system, or otherwise make such false alarm.

Section III:- Any person or persons who will violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder, be fined not less than \$20.00 nor more than \$50.00 or be confined in the City Jail not more than 25 days for each and every offense as may be determined by the Court.

Section IV:- This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval by the Mayor.
