An Ordinance to provide for the regulation and closing of Saloons, Bar-Rooms, and other places during certain hours, when Spirituous, Fermented, Malt and Vinous Liquor is sold or disposed of, and to provide a punishment for the violation thereof.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section I: - That any person or persons duly licensed to engage in the sale of spirituous, fermented, malt or vinous liquor, within the City of Albany, or any person in his employ who shall keep open, suffer, permit or allow any person whomsoever to visit his place of business, where such liquor is sold or kept for sale, at any hour on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, or upon any other day of the week, between the hours of 12 o'clock midnight and five o'clock in the morning of the following day, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the city jail for not less than twenty five days nor more than fifty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section II: - That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section III: - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
