

ORDINANCE NO. 401

An Ordinance authorizing the construction of a wooden curbing on the North side of Fourth Street, parallel with and twelve feet from the South line of Block Thirteen in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, at the cost and expense of the owner of the property adjacent to said curbing, and authorizing the Mayor and Recorder, of the City of Albany to enter into a contract on the part of said City for the construction thereof.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:—

Section 1. That there shall be constructed a wooden curbing on the North side of Fourth Street, adjacent to parallel with and twelve feet from, the South line of Block 13 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon the whole length of said block, said curbing to be built of plank three inches in thickness and twelve inches in depth, and to be constructed in all particulars according to the survey and specifications for the curbing in said street now on file in the office of the City Recorder for the City of Albany, Oregon. That the cost of the construction and completion of said curbing, shall be assessed to the owner of said Block 13, in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, being the premises adjacent to and benefited by the building of such curbing, and that the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to enter into and sign on the part of the City of Albany, written articles of agreement for the construction of said curbing; Provided that such contract shall not be entered into or such articles of agreement signed by the Mayor and Recorder, on the part of the City of Albany, until after proposals for the construction of said curbing have been advertised for in the manner provided for in the Charter and ordinances of said City regulating the awarding of such contracts and bids have been received and considered by the Council of said City, and the contract awarded by the Council, and the costs and expenses of constructing said curbing shall have been ascertained and determined.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
