

ORDINANCE NO. 415

Changing curb line on Montgomery street.

Ord 415

An ordinance changing the curb line on both sides of Montgomery street in the City of Albany.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That all curbing hereafter constructed or laid on either side of Montgomery street in the City of Albany shall be so constructed or laid on a line parallel with and nine feet distant from the line of the adjacent lots. In all other respects said curbing shall be constructed or laid in accordance with the ordinances of said city now in force governing such construction.

Sec. 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
