

ORDINANCE NO. 418.

Refunding money on unexpired saloon licenses.

An ordinance providing for the refunding to certain licensed retail liquor dealers of the City of Albany of a portion of the license taxes paid by them.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:-
Sec. 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the treasury of the City of Albany the sum of \$875⁰⁰, for the purpose of refunding to the herein-after named licensed retail liquor dealers of the City of Albany the proportionate part of the license taxes paid by them for that portion of the unexpired term of their respective licenses, beginning with the first day of July, 1906, as follows:

And the Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants upon the Treasurer of the City of Albany in favor of the said above named persons for the amounts set opposite their respective names, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of \$875⁰⁰.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
