An ordinance appropriating funds for the ordinary expenses of Chemical Engine Company No. 3 of the City of Albany.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:
Section 1. That there is hereby allowed and appropriated for the ordinary expenses of Chemical Engine Company No. 3. of the City of Albany, the sum of Six Dollars (\$6.00) per quarter, payable quarterly by warrant drawn upon the City Treasurer.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of November, 1906.
