An Ordinance to license, tax and regulate skating rinks, and to repeal Section two (2) of Ordinance No. 144. Entitled "An Ordinance to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses." Approved, February 10th 1886.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the owner, proprietor or keeper of any skating rink, shall pay to the City of Albany Oregon, a yearly license of \$100.00, every place, room or building where skating is carried on and chairs are made therefor, shall be deemed a skating rink under this Ordinance.

Section 2. That Section 21 of Ordinance No. 144. Entitled "An Ordinance to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses" approved February 10th 1886, relating to skating rinks be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
