The People of the City of Albany, do ordain as follows:  
Section One

The established grade of Sixth Street between Baker and  
Montgomery Streets in the City of Albany, shall be in  
Conformity with the survey and plat thereof, made by  
J. A. Warner, City Engineer, and filed in the Office of  
The Recorder of the City of Albany, on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of  
May, 1907.

Section Two.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict  
herewith are hereby repealed.

Section Three

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in  
force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
