All Ordinances relating to the construction of Alley crosswalks within certain limits in the City of Albany, and within the district described in Section Two of Ordinance # 413.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:  
Section 1. That all Alley Crosswalks that may hereafter be constructed within the district described in Section Two of Ordinance # 413 in the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be made of stone or cement and of the dimensions, and in the manner hereinafter provided.

Section 2. That all of said crosswalks shall be from 5 to 8 feet in width as the City Council may by order duly made and entered direct, with a curbed slope of two inches from the center thereof to a point 8 inches from the outer edges, and from said point there shall be an additional curbed slope of two inches, and said crosswalks, if constructed of cement or concrete shall consist of seven parts of gravel and one part of cement for the base thereof. Said concrete base not to be less than 6 inches thick and to be laid upon a bed of gravel not less than 4 inches thick, and the top dressing shall not be less than three fourths of an inch thick and composed of fifty per cent sand and fifty per cent cement.

Said crosswalks to be on grade in the center and a layer of gravel 3 inches deep and three feet wide to be spread on each side of said crosswalk and on the grade thereof, and that the expense of the construction of the same be borne pro-rata by the property owners abutting the Alley and extending to the center of the block from said Alley crosswalks.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after 30 days after its approval by the Mayor.
