

ORDINANCE NO 434

Fire Hydrants

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder to enter into a contract with the Willamette Valley Company a corporation for the construction and maintaining of eighty-six (86) Hydrants located within the City of Albany, Oregon, to furnish water for fire purposes through said Hydrants:

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, are authorized to enter into a contract with the Willamette Valley Company a corporation, now owning and operating a water works within the City of Albany, Oregon, to furnish the City of Albany, with eighty-six (86) fire hydrants to be located within the City limits and to furnish a sufficient supply of water through said hydrants for fire purposes, for the term of ten years, and to pay therefor the sum of One hundred Dollars per month during said period, the said hydrants to be placed within the said City as the Committee on fire and water and the Chief Engineer of the Fire Department of the City of Albany may designate.

Said hydrants to be not less than four inch pipes and furnish connections, and at all times to be supplied with a sufficient volume of water, and under a sufficient pressure to throw a stream of water through at least three (3) hydrants, at one and the same time through a two and one-half (2 1/2) inch hose one hundred feet (100) in length and through a one inch nozzle a distance of one hundred and fifty (150) feet and in case of fire or conflagration, to furnish a sufficient volume of water, and under sufficient pressure so that the City at one and the same time can use three (3) hydrants, each to throw a stream of water one hundred and fifty (150) feet distant.

Section 2. That before said contract shall become binding or effective upon the City, the said Willamette Valley Company shall execute a bond, with sureties to be approved by the Council, to the effect that said Willamette Valley Company, or its assigns, will keep said Hydrants in good order, and will comply with all the requirements provided for in Section one of this Ordinance.

Note: The foregoing Ordinance #434 was submitted to the legal voters of the City of Albany Oregon for their approval or rejection at the regular Election held on the 2nd day of October 1907. There were 111 votes cast for said Ordinance and 441 against same under the provisions of the Ordinance. The Mayor, dated December 6, 1907, by a proclamation of the Mayor, dated December 6, 1907, declared null and void the Ordinance and its effect.

Section 3. That the said Council reserves the right at any time during the term of this Contract, to amend and annul the same if the said Willamette Valley Company, or its assigns, shall fail to comply with all of the terms of this Ordinance, and the Contract made in pursuance thereof, if the said Council by majority vote determine to terminate the Contract.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after thirty days from its approval by the Mayor.
