

ORDINANCE NO. 444

Spitting in public places.

Be It Enacted

An Ordinance to punish persons by fine or imprisonment or both for spitting in any public place or public hall, or upon any sidewalk within the City of Albany, Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:-

Section 1. That any person who shall spit within any public place, public hall or stairway, or upon any sidewalk within the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of said City shall be punished for each such offense by a fine of not less than \$200 nor more than \$1000 or by imprisonment in the City Jail not less than one day nor more than five days or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of said recorder's Court.

Section 2. Inasmuch as many persons are in the practice of spitting in the public halls and public places and upon the sidewalks within said City, which practice renders said sidewalks, public places and public halls filthy and unclean in the extreme and injurious to the public health and safety of the citizens and inhabitants of said City, an emergency is therefore declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor of said City.
