

ORDINANCE NO. 446

Changing grade on Maple & Seventh Streets

A Bill for

an ordinance changing and establishing the grade of
all that portion of Maple Street in the City of Albany, Oregon,
between the center line of Eighth Street, and the center line
of Eighth Street, and all that portion of the grade
and seventh Street in said City between the west line
of Vine Street, and the center line of Walnut Street
so as to conform to the survey of the grade of said
portion of said Maple and Seventh Streets, as made
by, and shown by the survey and plan thereof made
by J. G. Warner, City Engineer, and filed in the
Office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, on the 19th
day of June, 1908, and to repeal all Ordinances,
or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the grade of all that portion of Maple
Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, between the Center
line of Sixth Street, and the center line of Eighth Street,
and all that portion of the grade on Seventh Street
in said City, between the west line of Vine Street, and
the center line of Walnut Street, be and the same
is hereby changed and established so as to conform
to the survey of the grade of said portion of said
Maple and Seventh Streets, as shown and made
by the survey and plan there of, of City Engineer
J. G. Warner, made in the year, 1908, and filed in
the Office of the Recorder of said City on the 19th day
of June A.D., 1908.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in
conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after thirty days from its approval by the mayor.
