State Bill form

An Ordinance to Ascertain, determine and declare the probable cost of certain proposed improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined by resolution No. 14, adopted by said Council of the second day of July, 1908, to make on First Street in said City from the East Curbline of Washington Street to the West Curb line of Lyon Street; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement of said First Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof, adjacent to said part of said First Street to be so improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the docket of City taxes, as provided by the Charter of said City, and to declare an emergency.

Whereas: On the 23rd of June, 1908, the Council of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of First Street from the East Curbline of Washington Street to the West Curb line of Lyon Street in said City with Bituminous Pavement, and for the construction of granite curbing wherever necessary, and for the installing of a proper drainage system, and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said First Street, and the probable cost thereof, and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the City Recorder's Office of said City, on or before the 30th day of June, 1908, said Resolution being endorsed, Resolution No. 10, and adopted on the 23rd day of June, 1908, and

Whereas: The City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said resolution No. 10, made plans, specifications, and estimates as directed by said resolution, for the said improvement of said First Street, in the manner specified in said resolution No. 10, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office of the said City of Albany, on the 30th day of June, 1908, Endorsed.


