

ORDINANCE NO. 470

Granting Barrett Brothers permission to erect shed

Repealed by Ordinance # 477

An Ordinance granting Barrett Bros permission to erect a temporary one story structure on the unoccupied part of the W. H. Goltra property at 137 West First Street on lot 7, Block 6, Albany, Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Barrett Brothers be and they are hereby granted the right and privilege to erect a temporary one story structure on the unoccupied part of the W. H. Goltra property at 137 West First Street, on lot No. 7, Block No. 6, in the City of Albany, Oregon, on the East side of the building now occupied by said Barrett Brothers.

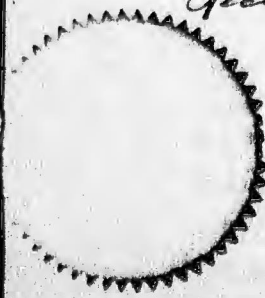
Said structure to be set on posts, and to be 24 feet wide by 100 feet long, and 14 feet high, the entire building to be constructed of corrugated Iron, and according to the drawing and plan thereof now on file in the Office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, and that said structure shall be removed at the expiration of two years from the date of the passage of this Ordinance.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after thirty days from its approval by the Mayor.
