Wooden Awnings and Signs over Sidewalks

An Ordinance regulating the Construction of wooden Awnings and signs over sidewalks on certain streets in the City of Albany, Oregon

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. No wooden awning, shade, balcony or porch shall be permitted over any sidewalk East of Washington Street and West of Montgomery Street between and including First and Third Streets in the City of Albany Oregon.

Both awnings when desired shall not be less than seven feet above the top of the sidewalk, and shall be supported upon iron arms so as to permit such awnings to be folded up against the building, the lowest portion of such arms or supports to be at least seven feet above the top of the sidewalk.

Sec. 2. No person owning or occupying any building or premises, or other person shall place or cause to be placed or maintained, or suffer upon the Street or sidewalk, or suspend or cause to be suspended over the same in front of such building or premises, or any building or premises, any sign or advertisement, or suspend or cause to be suspended, maintain or cause to be maintained, or suffer over the Street beyond the line of the curb in front of said building or premises, or any building or premises, any sign, advertisement or flag; Except upon holidays, Election days and days of public parade. And it is further excepted that Electric signs may be used, but to be so constructed as to swing back against the building during the day time, or when not in use.

Sec. 3. It is hereby made the duty of any person or persons, owning or occupying any building or premises now having or maintaining any wooden awning, shade, balcony or porch, or any sign or advertisement extending over any sidewalk, or Street in the district

Prohibition of Signs and Advertisements

described in Section One of this Ordinance, to remove the same within thirty days from the date of the approval of this ordinance.

Sec. 4. A violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder the offender, or offenders shall be punished by a fine of not less than five, nor more than fifty dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not less than two, nor more than twenty days for each and every offense.

Sec. 5. It is hereby made the duty of the City Marshal of the City of Albany to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

Sec. 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after thirty days from its approval by the Mayor.
